Ohio Star Table Runner

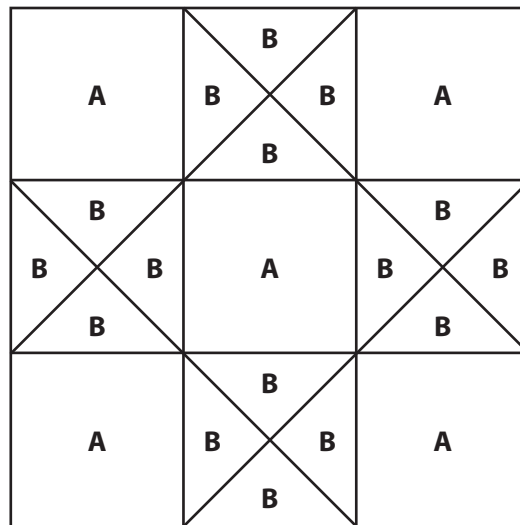
22 $\frac{3}{4}$ " X 52 $\frac{1}{4}$ "

Fabric Requirements

18" X 36" yard fabric for borders
 $\frac{1}{3}$ yard for setting triangles and binding
 $\frac{1}{2}$ yard off white for block background
Miscellaneous fabric scraps for blocks

Directions

Make three 9" Ohio Star blocks. For each one –
Cut four A's that are 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square from light colored fabric
Cut one A that is 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square from dark fabric
Cut sixteen B's by cutting four 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares from dark fabric and cutting each diagonally twice.
Assemble as shown.



Setting Triangles – Cut two 9" triangles and cut each diagonally once to make four setting triangles.

Borders – Cut two strips of border fabric 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " X 30" and four strips 5 $\frac{1}{8}$ " X 18." Sew the two long strips to the sides. When sewing the shorter strips at the ends, the border strips will overlap the side strips. Fold and stitch a seam here by whip stitching in place by hand. Trim excess fabric. At the pointed ends, allow one strip to extend to the end and stitch in place, by hand.

Binding – Cut 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " binding strips. Miter points and curve gently to fit around the side angles.
